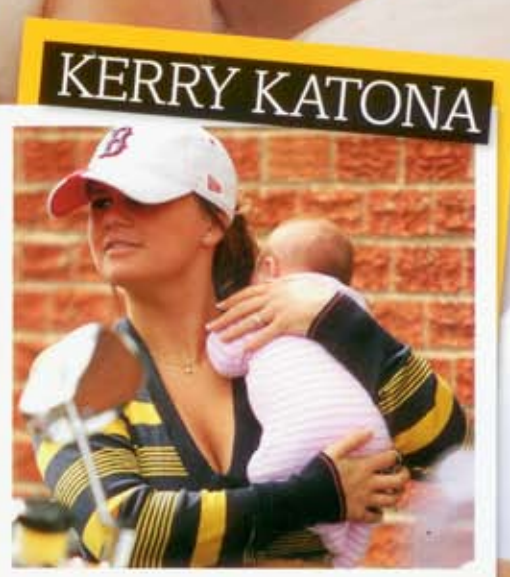

**EMMA SAYS** 'It's secure and easy to use, with the weight distributed evenly across my back. Some of the positions are a bit uncomfortable, though.'



**BRUIN TWO-WAY CARRIER, £19.99, BABIES R US**

*Tested by Katie Mouatt, 23, and Hollie, 10 weeks, from Hull*

**KATIE SAYS** 'This is stylish but all the buckles and clips are confusing! Hollie is comfy, but I'd like it closer to my body.'



**WILKINET BABY CARRIER, £43.95**

*Tested by Laura Brittain, 19, and Lily-Mae, eight months, from Bristol*  
**LAURA SAYS** 'This was a bit complicated at first, but it's very comfortable to use and Lily-Mae is happy in it.'



**HIPPYCHICK HIP SEAT, £34.95**

*Tested by Teresa Lodge, 34, with Max, 10 months, and Jack, three, from Nailsea, Somerset*

**TERESA SAYS** 'The Hippychick is amazing! Max loves it. He likes being high and he's really comfortable – he even fell asleep one day. And it's so comfortable to use. I expected to feel the weight on one side, but that's not the case. I have nothing but great things to say about this – it makes my life a whole lot easier!'



**BUSHBABY COCOON, £50**

*Tested by Chloe Turton, 19, and Elise Mai, five months, from Worksop*

**CHLOE SAYS** 'This is the first carrier I've tried. It's well padded and really comfortable. It's easy to adjust and gives very good support so I feel safe using it. It's simple to get Elise in and out as it separates easily into two parts.'

**CHRISTINE SAYS** 'Looks intimidating but it's surprisingly easy to use. Erin's secure and comfy.'



**CHICCO SOFT AND DREAM CARRIER, £39.99**

*Tested by Carley Brierley, 32, and Archie, six months, from Thornton Cleveleys, Lancashire*

**CARLEY SAYS** 'I love the colour and quality feel of this. I find it quite difficult to put together when I use it in the sling position though, and the straps rub my shoulders a bit. But Archie loves it!'



**BABYJÖRN ACTIVE CARRIER, £72.50**

*Tested by Emma Botwright, 32, and Lilli, 11 months, from Tyne and Wear*

**EMMA SAYS** 'This is easy to put on and it's easy to get Lilli in and out. It's well padded, so would be comfortable for smaller babies. The straps give excellent and even support so there's no backache.'



**TOMY FREESTYLE FLEECE, £29.99**

*Tested by Katy Warren, 31, and Caitlin, seven months, from Cambridge*

**KATY SAYS** 'This has a sporty feel but the side straps are stiff. Once on, the straps and lumbar support provide excellent comfort.'



**HUG-A-BUB, £48.50, NATURAL CHILD**

*Tested by Jade Williams, 27, and Tyler, 12 weeks, from Spalding*

**JADE SAYS** 'This is very easy to put on, and it's excellent for close contact with your baby. Although I felt silly at first wearing it in public, I soon got used to it.'
